

CDC Recommendation	TGS Procedures
Wear mask if over the age of 2	We will use behavioral contingencies to encourage students to wear their masks <i>as they are able</i> . Students will earn points for wearing masks. Staff will wear masks unless they are sitting behind plexiglass. Parents, please send two masks in a ziploc bag with your child's name on it. Or, if your child is able to wear their mask upon arrival, please send one additional mask in a labeled ziploc bag.
No sharing of items or supplies, electronic devices, toys, games or learning aids	Students will not share ANY materials. Staff will also not share iPads, computers or other materials.
Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces between uses.	Items will be sanitized after use. Each classroom will have a disinfectant area to sanitize items.
Develop a schedule for increased, routine cleaning and disinfection	The building will be deep cleaned prior to return. Daily cleaning and sanitation practices will be done. Frequent handwashing is incorporated into the daily schedule.
All belongings separated into individual spaces	Students will no longer share lockers. Each student will have a designated closed container, shelf or locker to place belongings.
Desks should be 6 feet apart and all face the same direction	Desks/tables have all been placed at least 6 feet apart. All classrooms are large enough to ensure 6 feet between people.
One way routes in hallways with tape on hallways or sidewalks to ensure children stay 6 feet apart	Tape marking directions to walk have been added to allow a 1 way flow of traffic around the building. Arrows have been placed 6 feet a part to note where a person can walk or stand to ensure social distancing.
No shared spaces including cafeterias and playgrounds	Students will eat in their assigned zone/area. We will <u>not</u> use the lunchroom, microwaves or fridges. Parents, please send bottled water and lunches in lunch packs that do not require a refrigerator or microwave for heating.
Reduce interactions	The school is divided into zones of instruction. Each student and teacher will stay in their assigned zone. We will adjust our typical teacher rotations to include only one teacher rotation change per day.
Stagger arrival and dismissal	Only one child and teacher will be in the arrival and dismissal area at a time.
Daily health and temperature checks	Each staff and student will answer CDC questions prior to entry. Temperature checks/hand washing/hand sanitizer upon arrival.
Illness	If a student or employee is sick, stay home. If a positive COVID test is confirmed, we will follow local health department guidance related to quarantine, cleaning, testing, and notification requirements.

Note: As we continue to monitor CDC and state recommendations, we will update and modify these procedures as needed.
